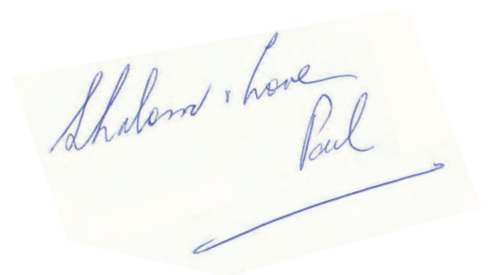
FEAST OF ALL SAINTS—1st November and FEAST OF ALL SOULS—2nd November

FIRST READING: Apocalypse 7: 2-4, 9-14

This reading is rich in baptismal imagery: marked on the forehead with the seal, white robes washed clean in the blood of the lamb. The reading also speaks of enduring through a time of trial.

SECOND READING: 1 John 3: 1-3

Our promise, that as God's children, we shall see God and not only that, we shall be like God. Living in that hope, we strive to live as Jesus lived.

GOSPEL READING: Matthew 5: 1-12

The beatitudes: the way of life we are called to live, to be a sign of God's kingdom. The saints whom we honour today are examples of such living of the being-attitudes which are the perfection of Gospel values.

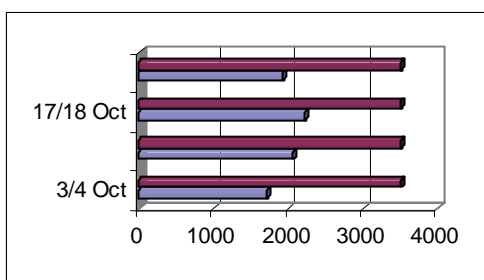
